Revised COVID Guidelines for GSLA Field Trips, updated Jan. 2022

As of January 4th, 2022, we have revised our COVID precautions. Here are the current precautions that GSLA is taking:

- Masks are recommended but optional for those who are fully vaccinated with booster.
- Masks are mandatory for those who are not fully vaccinated with booster (on the honor system).
- Trip leaders reserve the right to ask participants to wear a mask, so please bring one with you to all our field trips.
- Guidelines for kids and families may differ depending on the event (e.g., the GSLA Fledgling Club). Check with the event coordinator to obtain the latest guidelines for those events.

Note:

Sharing a car is the highest risk for COVID transmission. Individuals at high risk for COVID complications should carefully consider whether attendance is appropriate.

Please maintain social distancing at all times, even outside.

Do not join the field trip if you are experiencing the following symptoms:

- Coughing
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Muscle aches
- Sudden change/loss of taste or smell
- Fever or chills
